The program is run by a professional educator who is a licensed riding instructor at a certified Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship center.

On a daily basis, participants:

- Learn about horse care
- Do barn chores
- Enjoy a creative activity
- Take a ½-hour riding or horsemanship lesson
- Play horse-related games
